Agreement on the use of UGU-data

The agreement refers students use of UGU-data within the framework of a course or an education at universities. The agreement is drawn up between supervisor/teacher and UGU, and applies to the use of disclosed UGU-data within the period specified in the application. By signing the agreement the supervisor undertakes to inform the student or students about the following:

- 1. That disclosed data is only used for the essay/work specified in the application.
- 2. That disclosed data is only used by the supervisor and the students specified in the application.
- 3. That disclosed data is not sold or otherwise communicated to others than those specified in the application.
- 4. That disclosed data is stored so that no other than those specified in the application has access to them. This means that data must be stored so that they are protected by password. They can i e not be stored on USB, cell phone, tablet or similar devices if these lacks password protection.
- 5. Never try to identify individuals, families, households or organizations using the information in disclosed data. Data shall never be reported in a way that such identification becomes possible for others. According to Swedish law (SFS 2001:99, § 6 och § 26) can such backdoor give up to one year in prison.
- 6. To immediately notify UGU if disclosed data disappears or is stolen.
- 7. That the finished essay or work must contain a reference to:

- 8. That a copy of the essay or work is sent to UGU.
- 9. That disclosed data and working copies are destroyed/deleted when the essay or course work is finished.

UGU for its part, undertakes

- 1. To save a copy of disclosed data for at least ten years after the completion of the applicant project.
- 2. To answer questions about the meaning of disclosed variables and their coding.
- 3. To promptly correct and notify users of any errors detected in disclosed data.
