Population 1

Dates for testing program: 11 November 1983.

Timing of testing program: 6 weeks before end of
school year.

Desired target population: All students in Grade 5 at
the time of the
testing program.

Defined target population: All students in the 5th
Grade on 11 November 1983.

Excluded population: All students in the 5th Grade in
special schools and in
schools located in extremely small villages. Special
schools refer to ones which
the blind, the dumb, the physically handicapped, the
leprotics, and the mentally
retarded are enrolled. Schools in extremely small
villages refer to ones which
are located in places extremely remote from the rural
area, such as in small
islands, small farms or small mine places.

Population 2

Dates for testing program: 11 November 1983.

Timing of testing program: 6 weeks before end of
school year.

Desired target population: All students in Grade 9 at

the time of the
testing program.

Defined target population: All students in the 9th
Grade on 11 November 1983.

Excluded population: All students in the 5th Grade in
special schools and in
schools located in extremely small villages. Special
schools refer to ones which
the blind, the dumb, the physically handicapped, the
leprotics, and the mentally
retarded are enrolled. Schools in extremely small
villages refer to ones which
are located in places extremely remote from the rural
area, such as in small
islands, small farms or small mine places.

Population 3

Dates for testing program: 29 September 1983.

Timing of testing program: 10 weeks before end of
school year.

Desired target population: All students studying any
science subject at the
final-year secondary level (the pre-tertiary level).

Defined target population: All students in Grade 12
at the time of the testing
program on 1 April 1983 (other than those defined as
part of the excluded
population).

Excluded population: All students at the final-year
secondary level in special
schools or schools in remote areas on 1 April 1983.
Special schools are for the
blind, dumb, physically handicapped, leprotics, and
mentally retarded. Schools
in remote areas are located in small island, remote
places, border area,
Schools in regained land from the enemy, mine places,

etc.

Note: In the 1990/1991 version of the datafiles there were 2 versions of

the Korean data for population 3. The only difference was a difference in weights, where one version contained only weights for specialists.

As these weights seemed to be wrong, the right specialists weights,

as found in the sampling report, have been added to the first version

of the data and so only one version of the data remains.
